

## **MCC Homecoming Dress Code: Semi-Formal**

- Dress must be appropriate for a semi-formal occasion. Dress that is inappropriate or does not express modesty in judgement of dance chaperones will result in being denied admission.
- Attire must represent policies acceptable for the values taught in our **Catholic schools.**
- Dress code must be followed by students who attend MCC and their guests from other schools.

### **Dress Code: Young Men (acceptable)**

#### DO's

- Dress Pants
- Dress Shirts
- Dress Shoes
- Coat and Tie/Sweater and Tie
- Shirts must be buttoned and tucked

#### DON'T's

- No Denim (I.E., JEANS)
- No Athletic Clothing
- No Jerseys
- No Gym Shoes
- No Hoodies
- No baseball hats
- No Earrings or excessive obnoxious jewelry



## Dress Code: Young Ladies

Homecoming should reflect a more formal family occasion not a night on the town or at a dance club.

Dresses that are too revealing, are skin tight or form fitting, expose midribs/sides or cleavage, or are too short in length are NOT appropriate. Rule of Thumb: If you cannot kneel down or you are constantly pulling the dress down at the waist...**IT IS TOO SHORT!**

It is very difficult for Administrators to determine modesty as traditional interpretations are not the same as fashion and cultural trends. Modesty is a subjective interpretation. Chaperones and Administration have the final determination if a student's dress is appropriate. If in doubt, do not wear it.

- Semi-formal dresses, pant suits, skirts with appropriate tops
- Dress backs must not be lower than the waist.
- Dresses should not be any shorter than 4' above the knee. This includes slits in the dress
- **Dresses must NOT be too tight or form fitting.** Midribs must be covered even when arms are raised above the head.
- Appropriate undergarments must be worn and not seen.

- Strapless and spaghetti strap dresses may be worn. However, please be aware the cut in the front of the dress must not show cleavage.

Students who do not meet these requirements, may be asked to put on a change of clothes or sent home.
